

Key words – what is important in art today?


1. No AI – not using AI in art can protect originality, emphasize on human creativity. The imperfection in art can be perceived by people as a meaningful artistic element. Art must have its own soul to make it more authentic. Using AI to create art is unethical, because it often uses art from people that don't allow for it.

2. Expression and emotions – art has become a way to express who we are – our culture, feelings, struggles, and values. Art can also hold memories and personal stories. Art is a way to explore identity and each piece carries the artist's background, values, and worldview.

3. Accessibility – art today is more accessible than at any other moment in history, it's no longer limited to museums or galleries. Young people experience it on the street, on social media, in memes or music videos. Anyone can create and share art instantly.
